The 2024 edition of the Doctoral Summer School, organised by the PhD programme in Journalism and Communication Sciences of the UAB Department of Journalism and Communication Sciences, will focus on analysing the role of journalism and communication in the face of the challenge of disinformation. The programme has also reserved a special slot for students of the doctoral programme who will be able to present the progress of their respective research, learn about the work of their peers and participate in a holistic and transversal debate on the different milestones, the possible methodological approaches and the findings that the students of our programme have been and are generating in the framework of their doctoral work. In this edition, the programme includes a guided tour of the facilities of the General Library of Communication.



#### GUEST SPEAKERS



#### José María Martínez

Professor of Psychobiology at the University of Murcia.

Professor of Psychobiology at the University of Murcia, where he has been Professor of Psychophysiology and Physiological Psychology since 1978. He holds a degree in Psychology with an extraordinary award from the Universidad Autónoma de Madrid and a PhD cum laude from the University of Murcia, and has been a visiting professor at the universities of Lille (France), Guadalajara (Mexico) and Panama. He has also completed courses and stays at the University of Southern California, Harvard Medical School, the University of California in Los Angeles and Strathclyde University in Glasgow. Between 1992 and 1993 he was responsible for communication in the Technical Assistance Unit of the SPRINT programme for Innovation and Technology Transfer of the European Commission, and from 1995 to 1997 and from 1999 to 2003 he held the position of Director General of Universities and Research of the Community of Murcia. He has also been a member of the National Commission for Science and Technology and the National Commission for the Evaluation of Research Activity. He received the Knowledge Transfer Award (Dissemination in Health Sciences) from the University of Murcia in 2020. He is the author of Psicofisiología (1995), Manual de comunicación persuasiva para juristas (2023), Aprender a comunicarse en público (2001), Marketing de servicios profesionales (2002), La psicología de la mentira (2005), La gran mentira (2009), Technostress (2011), Jealousy (2013), Why Bullfighters Shave Twice (2016), The Lie + Story (2017) and Neuroscience of Learning (2018). He is also the author of the novel El espejo de seda (2020).



Luciano di Miele

Researcher at the UNINETTUNO University of Rome.

Researcher in Media Education and Educational Technology. He is currently working at the International Telematic University UNINETTUNO in Rome, where he teaches Education and New Media. He received his PhD in Pedagogy at the University of Rome "Sapienza" and prepared a thesis on "Video production in school". He has worked on several research projects on the use of media in educational environments and media didactics. She is a member of the journal "Media Education, Studi, Ricerche, Buone pratiche".



#### **Elianne Ros Woudstra**

Director of Media Relations at "la Caixa" Foundation.

From November 2022. Director of Media Relations at the "la Caixa" Foundation. She promotes the MediaHub Platform, launched on 28 February 2024, to innovate in communication and highlight the knowledge of Spain's leading Foundation. The platform is positioned as a benchmark and source of rigorous and reliable information for journalists in the main areas of knowledge of the entity: social, education, culture and research.

Since April 2017. Director of the Media Relations Department at "la Caixa" Foundation. At the head of a team of ten people in charge of the communication of all the Foundation's social, educational, research and cultural programmes in Spain and Portugal. This includes the communication of nine CaixaForum centres, CosmoCaixa (science museum), the digital platform CaixaForum+, the Social Observatory and CaixaForum Macaya (centre for debate and reflection), as well as the Cap Roig Gardens. He is director of the Observatorio de Cibermedios (UPF) and has been principal investigator (PI) of projects funded by the Spanish Ministry of Science and Technology's national R&D&I plan. He is a member of the Board of Governors of the Societat Catalana de Comunicació, a subsidiary of the Institut d'Estudis Catalans.
